RE: Sanctioned A Agility Match, November 12, 2010

Dear Ms. Legarretta,

It is my pleasure to inform you that the Calusa Dog Agility Club successfully met the Sanctioned A Agility Match requirements for clubs seeking to hold AKC agility trials. However, there is only one item needing to be brought to your attention.

The certification statement above the AKC logo should be replaced with the "Sanctioned by the American Kennel Club" and the "Scores awarded at sanctioned matches..." statements which was omitted. As it states in the Match Regulations, Chapter 10, Section 9, "The catalog shall bear the legends "Sanctioned by the American Kennel Club" and "Scores awarded at sanctioned matches do not count as credit toward any agility title." The AKC logo must appear with the above-indicated legends."

Please compliment the members for their hard work and willingness to contribute to, as well as participate in the excitement and growth of AKC agility. Recently, the AKC Board of Directors approved changes to the Regulations for Agility Trials, some were effective 9/1/10 and beyond. These changes are included in the regulation booklet, which can be downloaded by going to <http://www.akc.org/pdfs/rulebooks/REAGIL.pdg>.

Please note that the club should refer to the original correspondence received by the AKC Club Relations office regarding any necessary steps that need to be taken prior to submitting a presentation seeking permission to conduct licensed Agility Trials.

Once the club has completed the necessary steps, they may submit a presentation to **The American Kennel Club, to the attention of Michael Liosis, Director of Club Relations at 260 Madison Avenue, New York, NY 10016**.
